

ORDINANCE RELATING TO COUNTY ISSUED ON-SALE ALCOHOL CLOSING REGULATIONS

1.0 CONSUMPTION

Section 1. It is unlawful to display any alcoholic beverage in a Red Lake County issued licensed premises in Red Lake County more than fifteen (15) minutes after the legal time for making licensed sales.

Section 2. It is unlawful to allow display of any alcoholic beverage in a Red Lake County issued licensed premises more than fifteen (15) minutes after the legal time for making licensed sales.

2.0 CLOSING

Section 1. It is unlawful for any person, other than a licensee or their bona fide employees actually engaged in the performance of their duties, to be on the premises more than thirty (30) minutes after the legal time for making licensed sales.

Section 2. It is unlawful to allow any person, other than a licensee or their bona fide employees actually engaged in the performance of their duties, to be on the premises more than thirty (30) minutes after the legal time for making licensed sales.

3.0 OFFENSES

Section 1. Criminal Offense A violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor.

Section 2. Civil Penalty Violations of this ordinance may result in the suspension or revocation of an on-sale liquor license.

4.0 EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective at 12:01 a.m. on the first day of January, 2007.
